DEP intends to enter into a Government-to-Government Agreement with The County of Ulster Dept. of Public Works for CAT-459:Ashokan Rail Trail. The County of Ulster is the owner of the former Ulster and Delaware Railroad easement and intends to convert the existing railroad corridor, which runs through the City's Ashokan Reservoir lands, into a multi-use recreational trail. The City has determined that this conversion from rail to trail use is in the best interests of protecting the water supply and has agreed as a joint project to work cooperatively with the County to provide financial support and other assistance to develop the Ashokan Railroad Easement into the Ashokan Rail Trail, which will improve public access to the Watershed Property, expand recreational opportunities in the County, and increase economic development and tourism opportunities in the communities along the Ashokan Rail Trail.
